- Bookings are not required except for formal competition matches or lessons or special events.
- The Greenkeeper has PRIORITY, to mow the lawns. Please stop play immediately ALWAYS remove hoops to assist.
- Coloured areas are CLUB PLAY sessions for social play. Please do not pre-arrange games but play with any other members who arrive for Club Play.
- OPEN PLAY lawns are available for members to play any form of croquet.
- VISITORS FEES: Members of another Club \$10; A member may occasionally bring personal friends to play at the club for a \$15 fee, each .

Arrangements for Play during Club Play Sessions

Mosman presently plays three forms of croquet: Association and Golf, and Ricochet. There are designated 'CLUB PLAY' periods for these codes, when members can roll up and find other members to play with.

During all forms of CLUB PLAY, if social play does not need all the lawns, games may be arranged by members for other forms of play - at their discretion.

Association Croquet & Ricochet Sessions

Members should **arrive at least 10 minutes** before the start time. Games will be arranged by the Games Captain or another member by draw or agreement.

- Singles or doubles may be played
- Competition matches are permitted, provided they can be fitted in to the draw

Golf Croquet Sessions

Most Golf Croquet Sessions are intended for social play. The normal form of play is doubles, and is a great opportunity for new members to meet other members and play in partnership with more experienced members. Members are asked not to pre-arrange matches during Golf Croquet Club Play. If however, social play clearly does not need all the lawns, singles and competition matches may be played.

Wednesday morning GC play commences at 8:30AM, with a draw to allocate players. For sessions other than specific GC play (Div 1 / 2, coaching, etc), members can just arrive to play. If lawns are fully occupied, players should stop once completing a game to allow members who are waiting to play. Players in existing games may invite new arrivals to join them, but this is not obligatory if their game already has 4 persons members playing.

Singles Golf Croquet Sessions – on Fridays at 8:30AM

These sessions are to encourage members to play singles with a view to improving their game. Players **should arrive at least 10 minutes** prior to start time.

- Games will be arranged by draw of names
- Singles only to be played (however handicap, advantage, competition, etc may be options)
- Change opponents after each game.
- Singles GC Sessions may occasionally be booked for other events such as pennants, corporate functions, etc.

Division 1 & 2/ Division 3 / Coaching Sessions

These are specifically allocated to help members improve their game

Members are asked to respect these guidelines. They are intended to allow all members to enjoy the forms of croquet they prefer. Please only go outside these guidelines if your actions will clearly not affect the enjoyment of other players. Common sense and goodwill will solve most problems.
